Enclosed for filing in the above-referenced proceeding are copies of a recent order (Order No. 10-291) by the Administrative Law Judge presiding over the Oregon Public Utility Commission's consideration of the CenturyLink/Qwest merger proceeding. This order is submitted as supplemental authority in support of the Joint Applicants' July 21, 2010 motion for a protective order for highly-confidential information.

In the order, the Oregon Commission adopted, with slight modifications, a protective order CenturyLink had proposed, based on the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's original protective order, which included limiting highly-confidential information to only outside counsel and outside experts, and rejecting a request for a "small company" exception to those limitations. See Order No. 10-291, p. 5, and fn. 9. The specific "Staff's Eyes Only" provision which the Joint Applicants seek here was not at issue in CenturyLink's motion in Oregon.
