Dear Diane:

On November 10, 2010, the Utah Public Service Commission received a request for a waiver of the threshold requirements by Qwest. The wavier request is to allow the 435-868-6XXX 1,000 block NXX to be issued to Qwest in the Cedar City Rate Center to allow Qwest to meet a contiguous 500 number customer request which Qwest cannot provide based on its current inventory.

Through correspondence, Qwest has substantiated a verifiable need for additional numbering resources. Qwest donated this specific block back to the pool in 2003 and it is still available for assignment. Thus, based on the authority delegated to the states in paragraph 61 of the FCC's Third Report and Order on Numbering Resource Optimization, the Utah Public Service Commission grants Qwest's request for a waiver of the threshold requirements, thus allowing Nuestar, inc. to provide Qwest with the necessary block in the 435 NPA.
