## **ISSUE:**

Navajo Communications is filing this docket to modify its tariff to change the name of Frontier Digital Phone Essentials to Frontier Digital Phone 100 and introduce a new bundle called Frontier Digital Phone Essentials available to residential customers.

This change appears in Section 8 under Bundled Services. An existing bundle is renamed and a new bundle is given the name of the existing bundle.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Division has reviewed this modification for any rate increase to base rates that would require a rate hearing and has found none. However, Navajo filed an advice letter on April 8<sup>th</sup> to withdraw the original filing. The Division therefore recommends that the Commission <u>take no action</u> to approve this modification in Navajo Communications' tariff and, therefore, close this docket.
