Re: Utah Docket No. 10-050-T02, Navajo Communications Company, Inc. filing to change the name of Frontier Digital Phone Essentials to Frontier Digital Phone 100 and introduce a new bundle called Frontier Digital Phone Essentials available to residential customers.

ISSUE:

Navajo Communications is filing this docket to modify its tariff to change the name of Frontier Digital Phone Essentials to Frontier Digital Phone 100 and introduce a new bundle called Frontier Digital Phone Essentials available to residential customers.

This change appears in Section 8 under Bundled Services. An existing bundle is renamed and a new bundle is given the name of the existing bundle.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Division has reviewed this modification for any rate increase to base rates that would require a rate hearing and has found none. However, Navajo filed an advice letter on April 8th to withdraw the original filing. The Division therefore recommends that the Commission take no action to approve this modification in Navajo Communications' tariff and, therefore, close this docket.
