This matter is before the Commission on SBC Long Distance, LLC's Application to Cancel their CPCN to Provide Local Exchange Services in the State of Utah. The applicant was issued its CPCN on September 22, 2004 in Docket 04-2427-01. The applicant was granted approval to discontinue local exchange service to residential customers in June 2007 and approval to discontinue local exchange service to business customers in April 2010. The applicant currently serves no customers in Utah and is requesting its CPCN be cancelled.

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) reviewed the application and found the applicant complied with Utah Admin. Code R746-350 detailing requirements for exiting, and recommended granting the application. The Division also noted the applicant will continue to serve as an interexchange, carrier providing intrastate and interstate long distance to business and residential customers.

ORDER

The application is granted. The applicant's CPCN No. 2427 is cancelled. Pursuant to Sections 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15 of the Utah Code, an aggrieved party may request agency review or rehearing of this Order by filing a written request with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of this Order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing

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must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission does not grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of the request, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a petition for review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any petition for review must comply with the requirements of Sections 63G-4-401 and 63G-4-403 of the Utah Code and Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
