By The Commission:

On September 24, 2012, the Commission held a technical conference in this docket at which the participants discussed the need for the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) to file a “draft” business proposal outlining the business requirements the Division of Workforce Services will incorporate into its eRep system concerning the Lifeline Program. On October 1, 2012, pursuant to the scheduling order issued on September 25, 2012, the Division filed its “draft” Lifeline (UTAP) Program business proposal after emailing and incorporating comments from the parties on the service list. Subsequently, the Office of Consumer Services (“Office”), CenturyLink, and Salt Lake Community Action Program (“SLCAP”) each filed comments.

ORDER

After reviewing the Division’s “draft” business proposal and filed comments from the Office, CenturyLink, and SLCAP, the Commission determines that circulating an edited draft for final comments would aid the Commission in issuing its order on the Lifeline (UTAP) Program business proposal, as well as provide clarity and consistency to the draft. A copy of the

edited draft in “redline” form is attached hereto as Exhibit A. Interested parties have 7 days from the date of this Order to file comments on the edited draft.
