**Notice is hereby given that the scheduling conference in the above-entitled matter previously noticed for September 30, 2010 has been changed.** The scheduling conference will now be held on **Wednesday, October 6, 2010 at 9:30 a.m., Fourth Floor Room 401**, Heber M. Wells state office building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.

As noted in the initial notice, this docket has its origins in a Report and Order issued September 13, 2010, in Docket No. 09-2511-01. There the Commission found the petition of TracFone Wireless, Inc. for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier (“ETC”) should be granted, subject to the Commission’s determination of the reasonable per transaction fee to verify Lifeline eligibility via the Department of Community and Culture database. The September 13, 2010, Report and Order establishes this docket (No. 10-2528-01) for that purpose. Since the findings in this docket may affect the operations of all ETCs, this notice is being served not only on TracFone and the other parties in Docket No. 09-2511-01, but on the petitioners and other parties in Docket Nos. 10-2521-01 (Virgin Mobile USA, L.P.) and 10-2526-01 (i-wireless, LLC).

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At the scheduling conference, parties should be prepared to define the issues that need to be addressed in this docket, and to establish an expeditious schedule for discovery, the distribution of pre-filed testimony, and hearings.

Individuals wishing to participate by telephone should contact the Commission at least two to three days prior to the conference to make arrangements. On the day of the conference, participants must call (801) 530-6716 or (toll-free) 1-866-PSC-UTAH (1-866-772-8824) at least five minutes prior to the beginning of the conference to ensure participation.
