and Adams Technology Group Corp. per Docket No. 11-049-21.

RECOMMENDATION (acknowledge): Corrected

The Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge the receipt of this Interconnection Agreement.

EXPLANATION:

On March 01, 2011, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed the Interconnection Agreement per the above-referenced docket in accordance with § 54-8b-2.2(1) (d) of the *Utah Code*. At that time the Division advised the Commission to deny the interconnection agreement because Adams Technology Group Corp ("ATG") did not have the required Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in place.

After speaking with Chris Adams, President of ATG Corp. on March 31, 2001 we find that ATG is a reseller of non-regulated Broadband services only. They do not currently or plan to offer any telecommunication services to their customers in the future. Based on this information the Division requests that the Commission acknowledge the receipt of this Interconnection Agreement to resell broadband services supplied by Qwest.
