**RE: Docket No. 12-041-T07 Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah (Citizens) d/b/a Frontier Communications of Utah filing to correct the number of Additional Bundle (4 to10) lines to (4 to 12) lines within the Frontier Simply Unlimited Service-Leader new Business bundled service.**

**ISSUE:**

Citizens is filing this docket to modify its tariff to correct the number of Additional Bundle (4 to10) lines to (4 to 12) lines in a new bundled service offering for business customers.

This change appears in Schedule No. A-3 under Bundled Services.

**RECOMMENDATION: Approve Tariff Modification**

The Division has reviewed this modification for any rate increase to base rates that would require a rate hearing and has found none. The Division therefore recommends that the Commission approve this modification in Citizens' tariff and have it become effective on October 28, 2012.

Note: Citizens originally filed for this modification in its letter of September 27, 2012, which corrected the new bundle proposal in Docket No. 12-041-T06. The Division advised Citizens that a new docket number would be required for a proper paper trail when making another tariff change.
