Dear Ms. Kirby,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the January 24, 2020 filing by Q LINK WIRELESS LLC (“Q Link”), of an update to its Lifeline service offering. Q Link’s filing complies with requirements of the FCC and R746-8-403(2)(a)(ii). Consistent with the FCC’s November 19, 2019 Order, Q Link has increased its broadband Lifeline offering to include 3.0 GB of data per month. The PSC also reviewed the January 28, 2020 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). The DPU confirms Q Link’s Lifeline offering satisfies the relevant FCC and Utah requirements, and recommends the PSC acknowledge Q Link’s proposed changes to its Lifeline offering.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and the DPU’s response, the PSC acknowledges receiving the notice of changes to Q Link’s Lifeline service offering as described in its January 24, 2020 filing.
