## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Division recommends that the Commission holds a scheduling conference in this Docket.

## **ISSUES:**

On June 20, 2012 Telrite Corporation d/b/a Life Wireless LLC ("Life Wireless") filed with the Commission notice that the FCC had approved their Compliance Plan allowing them to seek approval as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC"). On July 30, 2012 the Commission issued an order staying the petition of Life Wireless request for ETC until a compliance plan had been approved by the FCC. In the Order the Commission stated that a party could file a motion with the Commission explaining the reason why it is necessary to lift the stay. With the acceptance of the Compliance Plan by the FCC of Life Wireless, the Division believes the reason for the stay in this Docket is no longer valid and requests the Commission establish a schedule for filing testimony, intervention of interested parties, and hearing dates for this docket.
