RECOMMENDATION:

The Division recommends that the Commission suspend testimony in this docket.

ISSUES:

On March 26, 2013 interested parties in this Docket met for a Settlement Conference. In addition to Telrite Corporation and the Division of Public Utilities, representatives from the Office of Consumer Services and URTA were present. Many items were discussed by each party and different issues were resolved. All of the parties are in agreement that within approximately the next 30 days, parties will have a stipulation in this Docket to submit to the Commission.

Originally, the schedule in this Docket had established a filing deadline for testimony as follows:

Direct Testimony of non-Applicants	Tuesday, April 16, 2013
Rebuttal Testimony – All parties	Tuesday, May 7, 2013
Surrebuttal Testimony – All Parties	Tuesday May 21, 2013



Because all parties agree that a Stipulation will be reached in this Docket and as an effort to efficiently maximize the time of all parties, the participants are asking the Commission to suspend any additional requirements to file testimony. If for some reason an agreement cannot be reached by the parties, a request to accept additional testimony will be filed with the Commission.
