The Public Service Commission of Utah (“PSC”) reviewed the December 5, 2017 filing by Telrite Corporation, dba Life Wireless (“Telrite Corporation”), of an update to its lifeline service offering. The PSC also reviewed the December 21, 2017 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (“DPU”). The DPU states Telrite Corporation’s filing fulfills the notification requirement for changes to Telrite Corporation’s Lifeline service offering.¹ The DPU concludes there is no reason to deny the changes and recommends the PSC acknowledge the changes.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and the DPU’s response, the PSC acknowledges receiving the notice of changes to Telrite Corporation’s Lifeline service offering as described in its December 5, 2017 filing, with a December 1, 2017 effective date as indicated in the filing.
