Dear Ms. Berlin,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the January 8, 2020 filing by Telrite Corporation d/b/a Life Wireless ("Telrite"), of an update to its Lifeline service offering. Telrite's filing complies with requirements of the FCC and R746-8-403(2)(A)(ii). Consistent with the FCC's November 19, 2019 Order, Telrite has increased its broadband Lifeline offering to include 3.0 GB of data per month. The PSC also reviewed the January 13, 2020 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). The DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge Telrite's proposed changes to its Lifeline offering.

Based on the PSC's review of the filing and the DPU's response, the PSC acknowledges receiving the notice of changes to Telrite's Lifeline service offering as described in its January 8, 2020 filing.
