True Wireless, LLC ("True Wireless"), by its attorneys, files the enclosed motion to withdraw, without prejudice, its above-referenced Petition of True Wireless, LLC for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 214(e) (the "Petition").

True Wireless filed the Petition on July 16, 2012. Thus, it has been pending for approximately 21 months. Under the terms of the *Lifeline Reform Order* issued by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), True Wireless was required to submit a Compliance Plan to the FCC.
