Dear Ms. Wirth,

On August 26, 2013, the Utah Public Service Commission received a request for a waiver of Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements by Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink (CenturyLink). The request is for three blocks of 1,000 sequential numbers in the 385-887-5, 6 & 7 blocks in the Midvale Rate Center to be used in the RVTNUTMADS0 switch, to meet the needs of a customer in the community.

Through correspondence, CenturyLink has substantiated a verifiable need and significant public interest justification for the requested numbers. The customer is moving from West Valley City (located within the SLKCUTWEDS0 Rate Center) to the Midvale Rate Center and will return the numbers it is currently using to the pool.

Based on the authority delegated to the states in paragraph 61 of the FCC's Third Report and Order on Numbering Resource Optimization, the Utah Public Service Commission grants CenturyLink's request for a waiver of the Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements, thereby allowing PA/NeuStar to provide CenturyLink with the requested telephone numbers in the 385 NPA, Midvale Rate Center to be used in the RVTNUTMADS0 switch.
