*Re: Amended Advice Letter--All West Communications, Inc. /Tariff Filing*

To the Commission:

In accordance with R746-405 of the Public Service Commission's Rules, All West Communications, Inc. ("All West") hereby files the original and two (2) copies of the following Revised Tariff Sheets of All West Communications, Inc. P.S.C.U. No. 1 Access Service Tariff on file with the Commission:

1. 7<sup>th</sup> Revised Sheet No. 208, canceling 6<sup>th</sup> Revised Sheet No. 208

This filing revises All West's Terminating Local Transport Termination Charge from \$0.026/min to \$0.002171/min., and adds a rate element for Local Transport Facility Charges for terminating traffic at the rate of \$0.000418 per mile. These changes are by the FCC's November 18, 2011 Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in WC Docket Nos. 10-90, etc. ("FCC Transformation Order"), paragraph 801 and should be effective July 1, 2013.

This filing should replace the filing made on May 31, 2013, because in the May 31, 2013 filing All West inadvertently included an increase in the Local Transport Facility Charges for originating traffic at the rate of \$0.000418 per mile. The originating rate should have stayed at \$0.00. Instructions from NECA (via the FCC Staff) provided that Rural Local Exchange Carriers with some intrastate terminating switched access rates above and some below interstate rates should raise the lower intrastate rates to parity with interstate provided the effect was revenue neutral.

All West requests an effective date for this filing of July 1, 2013. If you have any questions concerning the above, please contact me at your convenience.
