By The Commission:

On June 19, 2013, Bear Lake Communications, Inc. (“Bear Lake”), Central Utah Telephone, Inc. (“Central Utah Telephone”), and Skyline Telecom (“Skyline”) (collectively, the “Companies”) filed a motion for continuance of the hearing scheduled in this matter for June 25, 2013, to August 29, 2013. The Companies indicate two of the three companies are presently engaged in preparing cost studies for the National Exchange Carrier Association (“NECA”), as well as preparing filings associated with the Federal Universal Service Fund (“FUSF”) data collection to NECA. Companies’ NECA and FUSF filings are both due by July 31, 2013, and require the Companies’ full attention of its regulatory personnel through July 31, 2013. The Companies represent they have conferred with the Division of Public Utilities and the Office of Consumer Services and neither party opposes the Companies’ motion for continuance.

NOTICE OF HEARING

Notice is given that the hearing previously scheduled for June 25, 2013, at 1:30 p.m. (MDT) is cancelled and is rescheduled for **Thursday, August 29, 2013, beginning at 9:00 a.m. (MDT)**. The hearing will be conducted by the Administrative Law Judge for the Utah Public Service Commission and will be held in the **Fourth Floor Hearing Room 451, Heber M. Wells Bldg., 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah**. This hearing is being rescheduled at the request of the Companies in this docket. All parties must have their witnesses in attendance and prepared to testify.

Participants attending by telephone should then call the Public Service Commission at the same number listed above five minutes prior to the hearing to ensure participation.
