RECOMMENDATION (Acknowledgement):

The Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge the requested name change from IntelePeer, Inc. to Airus, Inc.

EXPLANATION:

On or about April 22, 2014, IntelePeer, Inc. filed a letter with the Commission indicating their company will be changing their name to Airus, Inc. The change of the Company's name does not affect the rates, terms and conditions under which IntelePeer's customers would receive service. IntelePeer currently does not have end user communications customers in the State of Utah.
