By The Commission:

On December 23, 2013, Skyline Telecom (“Skyline”) filed an advice letter to update its tariff maps in the following Skyline exchanges: 1) Eureka Exchange 433; 2) Moroni Exchange 436; 3) Wendover Exchange 665; 4) Goshen Exchange 667; and 5) Dugway Exchange 831. Skyline further requested the Commission waive the 30-day effective date from filing requirement and allow the tariff to take effect January 1, 2014. Skyline explains “that the revisions identify and define the existing service area boundaries for the applicable Skyline [e]xchanges. Therefore, an immediate effective date will benefit subscribers and prospective subscribers in inquiries related to service area boundaries in the Skyline [e]xchanges.” Advice Letter, filed December 23, 2013 at 2.

On December 27, 2013, in response to a Commission action request, the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) recommended approval of Skyline’s proposed updated tariff maps for the Skyline exchanges. See Division Memorandum, filed December 27, 2013. The Division further recommended the change become effective January 1, 2014, as requested by Skyline. See id. at 2.

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Under Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-12(5)(a), the Commission may grant a tariff change take effect in less than 30 days after the date of filing.

ORDER

For the foregoing reasons, and for other good cause appearing, the Skyline exchange tariff maps shall take effect January 1, 2014.

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Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
