## **ISSUE:**

On March 19, 2014 Citizens submitted a filing to decrease the Hearing or Speech Impaired Surcharge, pursuant to Rule 746-343-15.

## **RECOMMENDATION:** Approve tariff filing.

The DPU reviewed this filing and determined that it agrees with the current rule change for R746-343 which lowers the Hearing and Speech Impaired Surcharge from \$0.05 per line to \$0.02 per line effective May 1, 2014. The Division recommends that Citizens' tariff change also become effective on that date.
