RE: Docket No. 14-041-T05 Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah filing to correct the tariff for rates that currently mirror the interstate tariffs and are therefore, not exceptions to the interstate tariff.

## **ISSUE:**

Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah d/b/a Frontier Communications of Utah is filing revisions to its Intrastate Access Service Tariff PSC Utah No. 1-T. This access service tariff change will correct the tariff to remove the portions of switched access service that are not exceptions. They appear elsewhere in the interstate tariff rates

## **RECOMMENDATION: Approve New Tariff Changes**

The Division reviewed the reasons for making this correction and determined they were valid.

The Division agrees that this Tariff correction is required to cleanup this section so that it is understandable and clear that this service is not an exception. The Division supports this change and recommends that the tariff be approved and become effective on July 17, 2014.
