Integra Telecom of Utah, Inc. (Integra), on behalf of itself and its affiliates, respectfully provides this update to its July 21, 2014 comments on Qwest Corporation dba: CenturyLink QC's ("CenturyLink"), June 20, 2014 petition requesting Commission approval of 2014 Additions to its Non-Impaired Wire Center List.

Integra submitted comments on July 21st in this docket indicating that Integra was in the process of, but unable to complete, a review of the data supporting CenturyLink's petition to reclassify the wire center tier designations of the American Forks and Orem wire centers. At that time, Integra was unable to confirm the fiber-based collocation status of the carriers CenturyLink identified in its supporting data. In its comments, Integra indicated that to the extent that all carriers verify their status as fiber-based collocators in Orem (OREMUTMA) and American Forks (AMFKUTMA), Integra would withdraw its objection to the reclassification of these wire centers.

Integra has completed its review of CenturyLink's data and based on discussions with the fiber-based collocators, CenturyLink, and Commission staff, Integra withdraws its previous objection and is unopposed to CenturyLink's petition to reclassify the Orem (OREMUTMA) wire center classification from Tier 2 to Tier 1; and the American Fork (AMFKUTMA) wire center from a Tier 3 wire center to a Tier 2.

Integra appreciates the involvement of Commission staff and cooperation from CenturyLink and the fiber-based collocators.
