Dear Executive Secretary:

Cypress hereby notifies the Utah Public Service Commission (the "Commission") that Cypress will cease operations in Utah effective December 31, 2014. Cypress respectfully requests withdrawal of Cypress's Utah Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

Cypress is a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of Delaware with its principal place of business located at 75 Erieview Plaza, Suite 400, Cleveland, Ohio 44114. Cypress specializes in Voice over Internet Protocol services, which allows customers to make and receive voice communications over the Internet. Cypress was authorized to provide IXC and Local Exchange IXC services in Utah on July 22, 2002, pursuant to authority granted by the Commission in Docket No. 02-2389-01.

Changing market conditions require Cypress to cease operations. <u>Cypress has no customers and no active lines in Utah.</u> Cypress also hereby requests cancellation of any active tariffs that it may have in Utah.
