Integra Telecom of Utah, Inc., Electric Lightwave, LLC, and Eschelon Telecom of Utah, Inc. (collectively "Integra"), respectfully provide this update to its comments submitted in response to Qwest Corporation dba: CenturyLink QC's ("CenturyLink's") petition requesting Commission approval of its 2015 additions to its Non-Impaired Wire Center List.

Integra filed comments in this docket on July 15, 2015 indicating Integra initiated, but had not completed, a verification of CenturyLink's data supporting its petition to change the non-impairment tier designation status of the American Fork (AMFKUTMA) wire center from a Tier 2 to a Tier 1 wire center; the Kaysville (KYVLUTMA) wire center from a Tier 3 to Tier 2 wire center; and the Salt Lake City East (SLKCUTEA) wire center from a Tier 2 to Tier 1 wire center based on the number of fiber-based collocations in each wire center.

On July 23, 2015 the Utah Department of Commerce, Division of Public Utilities (the Division) filed a memorandum, indicating that it completed an investigation and received independent confirmation from each carrier CenturyLink identified as a fiber-based collocator in the data supporting its petition. Integra greatly appreciates the Division's independent review of CenturyLink's petition.

Based on the Division's filing, discussions with the Division regarding its filing, and Integra's independent investigation of carriers CenturyLink identified as fiber-based collocators, Integra does not object to CenturyLink's petition to re-classify the American Fork (AMFKUTMA)

wire center from a Tier 2 to a Tier 1 wire center; the Kaysville (KYVLUTMA) wire center from a Tier 3 to a Tier 2 wire center; and the Salt Lake City East (SLKCUTEA) wire center from a Tier 2 to Tier 1 wire center
