Re: In the Matter of X5 Solutions, Inc. Notice of Withdrawal of their Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, Docket No. 15-2426-01.

RECOMMENDATION (Approval):

The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) has reviewed the request by X5 Solutions, Inc. to have their Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) to provide Local Exchange Services in the State of Utah cancelled and recommends the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) grant this request.

EXPLANATION:

On or about August 20, 2015, X5 Solutions, Inc. filed with the Commission a request to have their CPCN cancelled. The Division has reviewed this request and found the following:

X5 Solutions, Inc. was issued a Certificate to provide telecommunications services in Utah on July 12, 2004 in Docket No. 04-2426-01.

On or about March 15, 2015, X5 Solutions, Inc. and X5 OpCo, LLC. filed a joint application requesting that all of X5 Solutions, Inc. customers be transferred to X5 OpCo, LLC. The Commission, on June 02, 2015, granted that request.

It appears they have complied with the rules for exiting as required under Administrative Rule R746-350.
