Airus, Inc. (Airus) hereby submits an original and five copies of this transmittal letter and revisions to Utah Product Catalog No. 2. These tariff revisions are being filed in accordance with the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC's") *Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in Docket Nos. WC Docket No. 10-90, *et al.* (FCC 11-161, rel. 11/18/11) and related orders, and Sections 51.911 and 61.26 of the FCC's rules. This submission includes:

- 1st Revised Page 102, Replaces Original Page 102

Airus hereby adds a cross-reference and URL hyperlink at page 102 to its interstate access tariff for the intrastate end office terminating access rate element. This will result in the intrastate end office terminating access rate element mirroring the Company's interstate end office terminating access rate element that will go into effect in July 2015 to implement Phase IV of the FCC's intercarrier compensation reform regime. These tariff revisions also modify the rate structure to establish separate originating and terminating rate elements for intrastate end office switched access. The rate element for originating intrastate end office switched access does not change. This filing is requested to become effective on July 31, 2015 (the same day Airus' interstate access tariff revisions are expected to go into effect).
