On June 16, 2016, CenturyLink made an FCC filing to increase the Federal Access Charge rate for Utah effective July 1, 2016. As a result, this filing is being issued to coincide with the increase to the Federal Access rate for primary residential service by revising the Federal Lifeline (ASGFX from \$6.39 to \$6.41 and ASGF2 from \$2.86 to \$2.84) while keeping the overall credit at \$9.25.

The Tribal Lifeline credits are also being changed as a result of the change to the Federal Access Change. Customers are not impacted by these changes.
