Re: Utah Docket No. 16-2201-T01, In the Matter of the Petition of Bear

Lake Communications, Inc., for an Increase in Rates to the current

Commission approved Affordable Base Rate

ISSUE:

Bear Lake Communications (Bear Lake) is requesting an increase in its basic business and residential telephone rates to the current Commission approved "Affordable Base Rate." Bear Lake's current monthly rate for Business (B-1) in the Garden City exchange is \$23.00 which will increase by \$4.50 to \$27.50. The current monthly rate for Residence (R-1) in the Garden City exchange is \$11.50 which will increase by \$6.50 to \$18.00. The current monthly rate for Emergency Line Service (E-1) offered in in the Garden City exchange is \$10.00 which will increase by \$8.00 to \$18.00.

RECOMMENDATION:

The FCC requires that the companies participating in the Connect America Fund (CAF), such as Bear Lake bring its rate levels to the CAF-mandated floor each year as a condition of continued participation. For 2016, the FCC rate floor is \$18.00 for residential subscribers.

The above basic rate increases are also pursuant to the Public Service Commission's Notice of Requirement to File a Petition to Amend Tariff or to Deviate from the Utah Affordable Base Rate (Notice) issued April 18, 2016, Docket No. 16-R360-01

Since the requested residential rate increase is mandated by the FCC for Bear Lake's continued CAF participation, and the rate increases comply with the requirements in the Commission's



Notice, the Division recommends that the Commission approve the new updated tariff sheets for Bear Lake in Docket No. 16-2201-T01 effective June 1, 2016 as requested.
