6	in the Matter of the Joint Application of EarthLink
7	Business, LLC; EarthLink Holdings Corp. and Windstream
8	Holdings, Inc. for Approval to Transfer Control of
9	Authorized Telecommunications Providers. There are two
10	docket numbers in this matter. They are 16-2287-01 and
11	16-2538-01.
12	Let's get appearances on the record. For the
13	applicants?
14	MR. EVANS: I am William Evans of Parsons,
15	Behle & Latimer for the joint applicants. And for the
16	joint applicants on the phone this morning is John
17	Fletcher from Windstream Holdings, Sam DeSimone from
18	Earthlink, and outside counsel for the joint
19	applicants, Jeff Strenkowski, from Morgan Lewis in
20	Washington, D.C.
21	ALJ JONSSON: I believe we also have Cesar
22	Caballero. Do we not?
23	MR. EVANS: Is Cesar on the phone?
24	ALJ JONSSON: Is Cesar on the phone?
25	MR. CABALLERO: I am on the phone, yes.

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Page 5 MR. EVANS: From Windstream. 1 2 MR. CABALLERO: Windstream. 3 ALJ JONSSON: Thank you. And for the Division of Public Utilities? 4 MR. JETTER: Good morning. I'm Justin Jetter 5 with the Utah Attorney General's Office representing 6 the Utah Division of Public Utilities. And with me at 7 counsel table is Ron Slusher, utility technical 8 consultant for the Utah Division of Public Utilities. 9 ALJ JONSSON: Thank you. Mr. Evans, go 10 11 ahead. 12 MR. EVANS: Thank you. We have filed on 13 November 16 the joint application for approval of the transaction described in the application, along with 14 three exhibits. We have also since then filed 15 16 supplemental exhibits, three of them, on December 19, 17 which we will address as we take testimony from the 18 witnesses. If you'd like, we can call our first witness 19 20 and start. I would request, and I can save this for 21 later or I can request now, that the application with 2.2 its exhibits and Supplemental Exhibits 1 through 4 be admitted into the record. 23 24 ALJ JONSSON: Is there any objection? 25 MR. JETTER: No objection from the Division.

Paqe 6 1 ALJ JONSSON: Thank you. 2 MR. EVANS: Okay. Thank you. Can we call Mr. Fletcher as our first witness? 3 4 ALJ JONSSON: Mr. Fletcher, do you swear to 5 tell the truth today? 6 MR. FLETCHER: I do. 7 ALJ JONSSON: Very good. If you have any trouble hearing Mr. Evans, let us know, and we will do 8 something about that. 9 THE WITNESS: Okay. His voice is a little 10 I'm hearing most of it, but if he can get a 11 soft. 12 little closer, that would be helpful. 13 ALJ JONSSON: Great. 14 EXAMINATION 15 BY MR. EVANS: 16 Okay. I have been the executive vice-president and general counsel of Windstream since 2006. I assumed 5 the responsibilities of chief human resources officer 6 in 2015. 7 Have you reviewed the joint application filed 8 0. 9 by Windstream and Earthlink in Utah? 10 Α. Yes. 11 And do you have personal knowledge of the Q. 12 matters set out in the application? 13 Α. Yes. 14 0. Are you the person who signed -- who signed the verified application? 15 16 Α. Yes. Are there any changes or corrections that 17 0. should be made to the joint application? 18 No corrections or changes are needed. 19 Α. 20 All right. Is Windstream asking the 0. 21 Commission to approve this transaction pursuant to the 22 informal procedures described in the Commission's Rule 23 746-349-7? 24 Α. Yes. Is Windstream or any of its affiliates 25 Q.

Page 8 serving as an incumbent local exchange carrier anywhere 1 2 in the state of Utah? 3 No, they are not. Α. 4 ο. Are Windstream and Earthlink required to file for Section 214 authority with the Federal 5 Communications Commission? 6 7 Α. Yes. Has that been done? 8 0. Yes. We filed with the FCC on November 17th, 9 Α. 2016. 10 11 And has that -- has that FCC application been Q. 12 submitted in this Utah docket? 13 Α. Yes. It was submitted as Supplemental Exhibit No. 1. 14 Has Windstream received notice from the FCC 15 Q. 16 establishing a pleading cycle for the application? The FCC's notice was issued on 17 Yes. Α. December 2nd, 2016. It required interested parties to 18 19 file comments on or before December 16th, 2016. 20 And is the FCC's notice the document that has 0. 21 been submitted in this Utah docket as Supplemental 22 Exhibit 2? 23 Α. Yes. Have there been any comments filed on the FCC 24 0. application? 25

Page 9 Comments in the docket for the FCC's review 1 Α. 2 were due on December 16th. As of today, our review of the FCC system does not show any comments in 3 4 opposition. So do you have an idea of when the joint 5 0. 6 applicants might have FCC approval to conclude this transaction? 7 So we have received the Hart-Scott-Rodino 8 Α. 9 Antitrust Approval from the Department of Justice. And 10 based on FCC precedent and the absence of opposition, 11 we anticipate that the FCC will approve the transaction 12 sometime during the first quarter of 2017. Do any state commissions other than Utah 13 0. 14 require Windstream and Earthlink to obtain approval 15 before closing this transaction? 16 Yes. The application filed with the Utah Α. Commission lists on page number 7 all of the states 17 18 that require approval. 19 ο. And have applications been filed in all of 20 those states? 21 Α. Yes. 22 ο. And I see that the New York application has 23 been submitted as Exhibit B to the Utah application; is that right? 24 25 Yes, that's correct. Α.

Page 10 Q. And are the applications that have been filed 1 2 in other jurisdictions substantially similar to the Utah and New York applications? 3 4 Α. Yes. Have any of the states in which approval is 5 0. 6 required approved the transaction as of today? Yes. Georgia, Maryland, and the District of 7 Α. Columbia have approved the transaction. 8 9 ο. And have those approvals been submitted to the Utah Commission? 10 11 Α. They were filed with the Commission on Yes. 12 December 19th as Supplemental Exhibit No. 3. 13 Have any other states approved? 0. Just yesterday, we received the 14 Α. Yes. approval from the Louisiana Public Service Commission. 15 And I will represent that we have filed that 16 0. Louisiana approval this morning as Supplemental 17 Exhibit 4, which we have handed to the Hearing Officer 18 and to the Division. 19 20 Mr. Fletcher, do you have supplemental 21 Exhibit 4 in front of you? 2.2 Α. Yes, I do. 23 0. Is this the communication you received from the Louisiana Public Service Commission? 24 25 Α. Yes.

Page 11 1 I notice that Louisiana's staff had filed a 0. 2 protest to the application. Can you explain that? Α. That is correct. At the time we filed the 3 4 application, staff could not verify that certain regulatory fees for one of the EarthLink's Louisiana 5 subsidiaries had been paid. As soon as evidence of 6 that payment was provided, the staff withdrew the 7 8 protest, and the application was deemed approved. 9 ο. Okay. In those states that have not yet approved the application, including Utah, have you 10 11 received or are you aware of any protest or opposition 12 to the transaction? 13 Α. No. 14 Ο. Have you received or are you aware of any 15 other protest or opposition from staff, third parties, 16 or the public with respect to any state or federal application for approval of this transaction? 17 18 Α. No. Have you filed notifications in all states 19 ο. that require only notification of the proposed 20 21 transaction? 2.2 Α. Yes. 23 0. Do Windstream and Earthlink have a date on which they would like to close this transaction? 24 25 We are targeting to have the Α. Yes.

Page 12 transaction completed by March 1st, 2017, assuming we 1 2 have received all of the required approvals. 0. All right. Can you please offer a summary of 3 4 why you believe this transaction is in the public interest? 5 Combining Windstream and EarthLink's 6 Α. Yes. resources and experience will provide each with access 7 to the other company's advanced network capabilities, 8 technical and financial strength, and complimentary 9 services, which together will enable the existing Utah 10 11 subsidiaries of both companies to continue to offer and 12 to expand a broad range of high quality competitive 13 services to enterprise and residential customers. The efficiencies and economies of scale 14 15 resulting from the transaction will improve the 16 combined company's economic position, which we expect will enable it to continue to attract financing, to 17 invest in, and offer new and innovative services. 18 Enabling small and medium-sized carriers to 19 20 achieve such efficiencies tends to create economically 21 stable competitors, which serves the public interest by 2.2 enhancing competition. 23 The transaction will also be transparent to 24 customers. Customers will not experience any immediate 25 change in their service or the rates, terms, or

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Page 16 Would you like to offer a summary of why you 1 0. 2 believe this transaction is in the public interest? 3 Α. Sure. The telecommunications industry has 4 been experiencing and continues to experience rapid innovative and technological advances that have led to 5 an increasingly competitive environment for carriers 6 like Windstream and Earthlink and their Utah operating 7 companies. 8 This transaction will combine the resources 9 of two well-established providers that have long 10 11 demonstrated their ability to deliver high quality 12 service to Utah customers. 13 Through combining the financial, technical, and managerial expertise of Windstream and Earthlink, 14 their Utah operating entities will be strengthened and, 15 therefore, better able to compete in the market for 16 telecommunications services to the benefit of all Utah 17 18 customers. The transaction will have no negative impact 19 20 on current customers of Windstream or EarthLink in 21 Utah. It is designed so that the current customers 2.2 will receive the same high quality service they have 23 come to expect without any interruption and without 24 change to service offerings, rates, or terms and 25 conditions.

14	filed this morning, December 21, 2016?
