RECOMMENDATION (Approval):

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") has reviewed the request by Questar Infocomm, Inc. ("Infocomm") to have their Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to provide Local Exchange Services in the State of Utah cancelled and recommends the Public Service Commission ("Commission") grant this request.

EXPLANATION:

On or about August 12, 2016, Questar Infocomm, Inc. filed with the Commission a request to have their CPCN cancelled. The Division has reviewed this request an found the following:

Questar Infocomm, Inc. was issued a Certificate to provide telecommunications services in Utah on July 12, 2004 in Docket Number 03-2416-01.

Questar Infocomm, Inc. currently has five customers using their fixed point-to-point transmission services, all of which use Infocomm's facilities to operate private communication systems or public services not regulated by this Commission.



It appears they have complied with the rules for exiting as required under Administrative Rule R746-350.
