Dear Mr. Evans,

The Commission has received the February 18, 2016 notice that Ionex Communications North, Inc. d/b/a Birch Communications (Ionex) intends to acquire Primus Telecommunications, Inc. (Primus). The notice has been docketed under case number 16-2563-01.

On March 18, 2016, the Division of Public Utilities (Division) filed a memorandum reviewing and summarizing the proposed transfer of control. The Division stated no objections to the transaction.

As you state in the notice, Primus does not operate in Utah as a public utility and does not hold a certificate of public convenience and necessity. Therefore, in acquiring Primus, Ionex is not acquiring another public utility. In these circumstances, the Commission agrees with your jurisdictional analysis. Commission approval of the transaction is not required, and the Commission will close this docket without further action.
