ISSUED: November 28, 2016

BACKGROUND

On June 2, 2015, in Docket No. 15-2580-01, the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) granted X5 OpCo LLC (X5) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, authorizing the company to provide public telecommunications services within the State of Utah.

On October 25, 2016, X5 notified the Commission that, effective November 1, 2016, it began operating under the name of Magna5 LLC.¹

On October 31, 2016, the Division of Public Utilities (Division) filed a memorandum noting that the name change will not impact customers, and recommending that the Commission acknowledge the new name.

ORDER

Having reviewed the records, the Commission acknowledges the name Magna5 LLC and amends the affected Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to reflect the new name.

The amended Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is attached as Exhibit A.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.

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ISSUED: November 28, 2016

The Public Service Commission of Utah, pursuant to the Utah Code Ann. § 54-8b-2.1, issues an Amended Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing Magna5 LLC to provide public telecommunications services within the State of Utah, excluding those local exchanges of less than 5,000 access lines that are owned or controlled by an incumbent telephone corporation with fewer than 30,000 lines in the state.
