Re: Utah Docket No. 16-576-T02, In the Matter of the Petition of Skyline Telecom, for a revision in B1 and R1 Rates that do not include mandatory EAS and State USF surcharges, but with their addition, sum up to meet the current Commission approved Affordable Base Rate rules.

ISSUE:

Skyline Telecom (Skyline) is requesting a revision in its basic business and residential telephone rates that, with the addition of mandatory EAS (Extended Area Service) charges and State USF (Universal Service Fund) surcharges, will add up to meet the current Commission approved "Affordable Base Rate." Skyline's current modification of its rate for Residential (R-1) to accomplish this is shown in the following table:

Additionally, Skyline has modified its tariff to reflect a business (B1) rate that is not inclusive of EAS, State USF surcharge, and State SLC, but whose sum of the B1, EAS, and State USF surcharge is at least \$26.00 as required by the Commission's Order:

Skyline is revising the Emergency Line Rates from \$18.00 to \$17.82. These rates are exclusive of EAS, State USF surcharge, and State SLC, but the sum of the Emergency Line Rate and the State USF is \$18.00:

RECOMMENDATION:

The FCC requires that the companies participating in the Connect America Fund (CAF), such as Skyline bring its rate levels to the CAF-mandated floor each year as a condition of continued participation. For 2016, the FCC rate floor is \$18.00 for residential subscribers.

The above basic rate modifications are also pursuant to the Public Service Commission's Notice of Requirement to File a Petition to Amend Tariff or to Deviate from the Utah Affordable Base Rate (Notice) issued April 18, 2016, Docket No. 16-R360-01

Since the requested residential rate increase is mandated by the FCC for Skyline's continued CAF participation, and the rate increases comply with the requirements in the Commission's Notice, the Division recommends that the Commission **approve** the new updated tariff sheets for Skyline in Docket No. 16-576-T02 and that the **Commission waive the 30 day notice period** and that the tariff becomes effective July 1, 2016 as contemplated in the Commission's Notices and Order in Docket 16-R360-01.
