Dear Mr. Widerburg:

Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink) respectfully requests a numbering waiver to obtain the additional numbering resources necessary to meet a specific customer request for a new campus expansion served by the LEHIUTMADS0 switch within the LEHI Rate Center. This waiver will allow PA/Neustar, the number pool administrator, to provide one block of 1,000 sequential numbers in the 801 NPA to meet a specific customer request. In the attached confidential letter, the customer requested 200 sequential numbers which CenturyLink cannot meet with existing inventory.

According to FCC requirements (47 CFR 52.15 (g)), to qualify for additional numbering resources a service provider must submit paperwork demonstrating that the rate center for which the numbers are requested is at or less than six Months-To-Exhaust (MTE) and is at 75% or more utilization. In cases where a service provider is not able to meet a specific customer request with available inventory, the FCC has determined that the state commissions will have jurisdiction to grant a waiver pursuant to FCC 01-362, Section IV, C, paragraphs 57-66. In paragraph 66 of this same order, the FCC recommends that the state commissions respond within 10 days of a waiver request.

To satisfy the customer's request, CenturyLink submitted a request for the numbers and supporting documents<sup>2</sup> to the PA/Neustar and the request was denied on December 18, 2018<sup>3</sup> because CenturyLink does not meet the utilization requirements and because the

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months-to-exhaust was too high. For the request to be approved, CenturyLink will require a waiver approval by the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) to override the PA/Neustar denial of resources.

CenturyLink respectfully requests that the Commission approve the request for this waiver and direct PA/Neustar to assign the requested 1,000 block of sequential numbers within the 801 NPA, and any block in any available NXX, with the exception of block 0,1, or 9. These numbers will be assigned to the LEHI rate center and will be used in the LEHIUTMADS0 switch. The directive can be emailed or faxed to:

#### Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia Technologies, Inc. dba iconectiv (iconectiv<sup>TM</sup>) LERG<sup>TM</sup> Routing Guide<sup>xi</sup>. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service

provider and the OCN of its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric NECA-assigned Company Code or a four-character alphanumeric identifier assigned by the iconectiv<sup>TM</sup> Telecom Routing Administration (TRA). In addition, the number of thousands-blocks requested should be supplied. The Switch Identification. Explanations of these terms may be found in the footnotes.

Section 1.3 The date the Service Provider completes the application should be entered in this section, as well as the Effective Date of the requested thousands-block.
