Dear Ms. Harrell-Simington,

On December 19, 2018, the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) received a request for a waiver of Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements by Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink). The request is for one block of 1,000 sequential numbers in the Utah 801 NPA and any block in any available NXX, with the exception of blocks 0, 1, or 9 within the LEHI Rate Center (to be used within the LEHIUTMADS0 switch), which CenturyLink cannot provide based on its current inventory.

Through correspondence, CenturyLink has substantiated a verifiable need on the part of one of its customers for additional numbering resources. Based on the authority delegated to the states in paragraphs 57-66 of the FCC's Third Report and Order on Numbering Resource Optimization, the PSC grants CenturyLink's request for a waiver of the Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements, thereby allowing Neustar to provide CenturyLink with the necessary number block in the 801 NPA LEHI Rate Center.
