RECOMMENDATION: Approve Notification

The Division recommends that the Commission approve Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC's ("CenturyLink") additions to the Access Service Tariff

BACKGROUND:

On February 9, 2018, CenturyLink filed updated information removing the direct dial coin feature from its access tariff. CenturyLink is removing this feature because it is no longer supportable due to the age of the technology and the inability to secure technical support and knowledge on how to make the feature work with the new SIP signaling.

The Division has reviewed the application and recommends the Commission approve the updated tariff. CenturyLink has requested the filing be effective on March 12, 2018
