Dear Ms. Harrell-Simington,

On April 25, 2018, the Utah Public Service Commission (PSC) received a request for a waiver of Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements by MCIMetro Access Transmission Services Corp. d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services (“Verizon”). The request is for three blocks of 1,000 sequential numbers (3,000 numbers total) in the 801 NPA Clearfield Rate Center, which Verizon cannot provide based on its current inventory.

Through correspondence, MCIMetro has substantiated a verifiable need on the part of one of its customers for additional numbering resources. Based on the authority delegated to the states in paragraphs 57-66 of the FCC's Third Report and Order on Numbering Resource Optimization, the PSC grants TCA's request for a waiver of the Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements, thereby allowing NeuStar, the Pooling Administrator, to provide Verizon with the necessary three number blocks in the 801 NPA Clearfield Rate Center.
