The Public Service Commission of Utah ("PSC") reviewed the April 9, 2019 filing by iwireless, LLC ("i-wireless"), notifying the PSC of changes to its Lifeline service offering in the State of Utah. The filing was made pursuant to the PSC's March 18, 2019 Order Approving Stipulation and Settlement Agreement in this docket.

The PSC also reviewed the April 23, 2019 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities ("DPU").
