Dear Ms. Kirby,

The Public Service Commission of Utah (“PSC”) reviewed the February 5, 2018 filing by Q Link Wireless LLC (“Q Link”), notifying the PSC of a change to Q Link’s Lifeline service offering. The PSC also reviewed the March 20, 2018 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (“DPU”). The DPU states Q Link’s filing fulfils the notification requirement for changes to Q Link’s Lifeline service offering.¹ The DPU concludes there is no reason to deny the changes and recommends the PSC acknowledge the changes.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and the DPU’s response, the PSC acknowledges receiving the notice of changes to Q Link’s Lifeline service offering as described in its February 5, 2018 filing, with an effective date of December 1, 2017.
