The Public Service Commission of Utah (“PSC”) reviewed the January 5, 2018 filing by Tempo Telecom, LLC (“Tempo Telecom”), notifying the PSC of a change to Tempo Telecom’s Lifeline service offering. The PSC also reviewed the January 31, 2018 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (“DPU”). The DPU states Tempo Telecom’s filing fulfills the notification requirement for changes to Tempo Telecom’s Lifeline service offering.¹ The DPU concludes there is no reason to deny the changes and recommends the PSC acknowledge the changes.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and the DPU’s response, the PSC acknowledges receiving the notice of changes to Tempo Telecom’s Lifeline service offering as described in its January 5, 2018 filing, with an effective date of January 31, 2018.
