Dear Ms. Wimer,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Central Utah Telephone, Inc.'s ("Central") proposed revisions to Page Nos. 48 and 50 of its Access Service, Central Utah Telephone, Inc., P.S.C. Utah No. 2 Tariff ("Tariff"), transmitted on May 31, 2019. Central proposes to modify End of Office terminating rates to be consistent with the requirements in FCC Rules. Central requests an effective date of July 2, 2019. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on June 10, 2019. The DPU supports Central's proposed modification and recommends the PSC approve the revised tariff.

Based on its review of Central's filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Central's proposed revision to its Tariff as filed, with an effective date of July 2, 2019.¹
