The Public Service Commission ("PSC") has reviewed Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah d/b/a Frontier Communications of Utah's ("Frontier") proposed revisions to Schedule No. A-8, Miscellaneous Service, Sheet Nos. 1, 4 and 4.1, filed on July 1, 2019. Frontier states the purpose of the filing is to introduce Vacation Get Away Service available to Residential Exchange Access Service as well as vertical features, bundles, and other basic services. Frontier requests an effective date of August 1, 2019 for the proposed changes.

The PSC also reviewed the July 9, 2019 comments of the Division of Public Utilities ("DPU"). The DPU states it has no objection to Frontier's proposed tariff revisions and recommends the filing become effective on or before August 1, 2019.

Having reviewed the proposed tariff revisions and the DPU's recommendation, the PSC approves the tariff sheets as filed, with an effective date of August 1, 2019.
