The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah dba Frontier Communications of Utah's ("Frontier") proposed revisions to Sheet Nos. 1 and 8 of its Schedule No. A-1, Network Access Line Service ("Tariff"), transmitted on October 28, 2019. Frontier proposes to incorporate the changes implemented by the 2016 FCC Lifeline Modernization Order. Frontier requests an effective date of December 1, 2019. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on November 12, 2019. The DPU finds no issues with the proposed revisions and recommends the PSC approve Frontier's proposed revisions to the Tariff.

Based on its review of Frontier's filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Frontier's proposed revisions to its Tariff as filed, with an effective date of December 1, 2019.
