The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah dba Frontier Communications of Utah's ("Frontier") proposed revisions to Sheet Nos. 1 and 4 of its Schedule No. A-8, Miscellaneous Service ("Tariff"), transmitted on October 28, 2019. Frontier proposes to include less restrictive language regarding its Vacation Get Away Service available to customers. Frontier requests an effective date of December 1, 2019 for these changes.
