Dear Mr. Somers,

On May 30, 2019, the Public Service Commission (“PSC”) received Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC’s (“CenturyLink”) Amended Interconnection Agreement (“Amendment”) between CenturyLink and Teleport Communications America, LLC in accordance with Utah Code Ann. § 54-8b-2.2(1)(d).

On June 3, 2019, the Division of Public Utilities (“DPU”) filed a memorandum, recommending the PSC acknowledge the Amendment. The DPU states it sees no reason to reject the Amendment as it was negotiated in good faith and without discrimination.

There being no recommendation to reject the Amendment, by law, the Amendment is acknowledged and shall be deemed approved on August 28, 2019, 90 days from its filing date pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e).
