Code R746-405-2(D)(6), and provide a statement the proposed tariff revisions do not constitute a violation of state law or PSC rule pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D)(3)(g). We conclude, without prejudice to dissimilar conclusions in future filings, that in this instance these deficiencies are not material enough to be a basis to suspend or deny the tariff.
