ISSUE:

Navajo Communications Company, Inc. dba Frontier Navajo Communications Company (Navajo) submitted a filing dated July 1, 2019 to introduce Vacation Get Away Service available to Residential Exchange Access Service. Vacation Get Away Service provides for temporary discontinuance of service at the customer's request without termination of service for a nonrecurring charge of \$39.99.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve tariff filing.

The DPU has reviewed this filing and has no objection to Navajo introducing this Vacation Get Away Service package to their existing tariff. The Division therefore recommends this filing become effective on or before August 1, 2019, as requested.
