## **Recommendation (Approve Tariff Sheets)**

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) approve the revised Tariff sheets of Carbon/Emery Telcom, Inc. (Carbon/Emery). The filing complies with the changes implemented by the 2016 FCC Lifeline Modernization Order.

#### Issue

On October 25, 2019, Carbon/Emery filed its 2nd revised tariff sheets on Nos. 31, 32, and 33, canceling the 1<sup>st</sup> revised sheets. On October 25, 2019, the Commission issued an Action Request to the Division requesting the Division to review the application for compliance. The Commission asked the Division to report back by November, 12, 2019. This memorandum represents the Division's response to the Commission's Action Request.
