The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah dba Frontier Communications of Utah's ("Frontier") proposed revisions to Pages No. 1, 1.1, 62, 63, 65, 66, 103, 104, 106, 107, 109, and 110 of its Schedule No. A-3, Bundled Services, Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah, Utah Tariff ("Tariff"), transmitted on May 7, 2020. Frontier proposes to grandfather its Stay Connected Seasonal Offering. Frontier requests an effective date of June 8, 2020. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on May 19, 2020. While the DPU explained that such service is convenient for customers and commonly available in areas where temporary phone service is desired, the DPU does not object to Frontier's proposed grandfathering of the service and recommends the PSC approve the requested tariff revisions.

Based on its review of Frontier's filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Frontier's proposed revisions to its Tariff as filed, effective June 8, 2020.
